Entry Requirements:

A grade 5 or above at GCSE is expected, but for those students who have not taken Art at GCSE, evidence of ability and commitment will be essential.

Please note that there may be some personal costs incurred for sketchbooks, large photographic prints, trips, life drawing workshops, etc.

What will I do?

- ◆ You will cover a very wide range of skills, ranging from 2D and 3D to photography, textiles, crafts, fine art and fashion.
- ◆ Enhance visual awareness and develop your ability to communicate and express yourself through the exploration and use of varied art mediums.
- ◆ Learning vast ranges of skills and drawing.
- ◆ By the end of Year 12 you will have identified your preferred progression route and should be working ideas through your choice of media.
- ◆ Translate and communicate meanings and messages by studying the work of fine artists through a range of styles and media.
- ◆ Produce final portfolios that are highly personalised with work ranging from drawing, painting, installations incorporating film, photography, textiles and sculpture.
- ◆ Visit art galleries, both local and in London.
- ◆ Study local artists and undertake life drawing.
- ◆ Partake in trips to university degree shows and Portfolio Advice Days.
- ◆ You will have access to an Art Study Room where you can work with other Sixth Form artists during Study Periods and/or after College.
- ◆ Assessment is provided throughout the course enabling you to know how to improve your own work, and; set and achieve personal targets.
- ◆ All Year 12 Art students are offered the opportunity to become an Art Ambassador, mentoring GCSE students.
- ◆ You will organise and participate in a final exhibition with a private view at the end of the year, to celebrate your achievements.

Is this for me?

Art, Craft and Design at Bodmin is a broad-based creative visual arts course with a contextual element that complements both a practical and academic A Level curriculum.

Students who opt for this course often pursue a career in the visual arts, as this course offers them a full and varied portfolio, with a wide skill set and knowledge of Art, Craft and Design.

Students on this course progress onto BA degrees in Animation, Games Design, Fashion, Surface Pattern Design, Fine Art, Illustration, Architecture, Textile Design, Jewellery Design, Animation, Photography and more.
