Entry Requirements:

A grade 5 or above at GCSE is expected, but for those students who have not taken Art at GCSE, evidence of ability and commitment will be essential. For this course, a good level of drawing skills is expected.

Please note that there may be some personal costs incurred for sketchbooks, large photographic prints, trips, life drawing workshops, etc.

## What will I do?

- Enhance your visual awareness and develop your ability to communicate and express yourself through the exploration and use of varied art mediums.
- Learn a vast range of skills and drawing.
- Translate and communicate meanings and messages by studying the work of fine artists through a range of styles and media.
- Produce final portfolios that are highly personalised with work ranging from: drawing, painting, installations, incorporating film, photography, textile and sculpture.
- Visit art galleries, both locally and in London.
- Study local artists and undertake life drawing.
- Partake in trips to university degree shows.
- You will have access to an Art Study Room where you can work with other Sixth Form artists during Study Periods and/or after College.
- Assessment is provided throughout the course enabling you to know how to improve your own work, and; set and achieve personal targets.
- All Year 12 Art students are offered the opportunity to become an Art Ambassador, mentoring GCSE students.
- You will organise and participate in a final exhibition with a private view at the end of the year, to celebrate your achievements.
