This will extend your creativity, communication, planning, teamwork and leadership skills.

It is beneficial both at a personal development level and also to support your progression through any education, training or career pathways.

What will I do?

- You will create a portfolio containing evidence of your work, your plans and the process of your development.
- Choose a format for your portfolio that reflects and expresses you as an artist - it can contain any medium or mix of media.
- Keep sketches, photos, notes, diagrams, DVDs and references from peers and professionals who have worked with you. This will end up being a wonderful resource and a professional document that will enhance your application to university and/or interviews for employment.
