Entry Requirements: What we offer? VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Beauty Specialist Techniques VTCT Level 3 Diploma in Beauty Therapy Treatments. Both courses are full time, 3 days a week.

There are no formal entry requirements for Level 2 however; it is preferable you pass Maths, English and Science. Applicants will be interviewed by specialist staff. Successful completion of Level 2 qualifications will enable you to progress onto a VTCT Level 3 qualification.



Is this for me?

The Beauty Therapy courses offered at Bodmin College are for anyone who is interested in employment in the beauty industry.

The qualifications are aimed at learners aged 16-19 who are in a full time education programme and wish to pursue a career as an employed and or/self- employed therapist.

After completing Level 2 & 3 you are qualified to work for a wide range of companies including health spas or cruise ships. Students carry out treatments in a real work environment, interacting with the public and completing projects, assignments, case studies and assessments.

What will I do?

LEVEL 2 VTCT - Health & Safety, manicures, pedicures, eye treatments, Eve Taylor facials, waxing, spray tanning, make-up application, fulfil salon reception duties, develop and maintain effectiveness at work.

LEVEL 3 VTCT - Health and safety, client care, body analysis, skin analysis, massage, pre-blended aromatherapy massage, body electrical treatment, facial electrical treatment, electrical science, mechanical massage, anatomy and physiology.
