**Entry Requirements:** There are no formal entry requirements for the VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing qualification, but in order to optimise your chances of success, we would expect good presentation and communication skills. In order to study the VTCT Level 3 Diploma in hairdressing you will need to have completed Level 2 first.

## What will I do?

The VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing is a qualification that has been specifically designed to develop your practical skills in; the creative art of cutting or dressing women's hair, how to provide effective shampooing and conditioning services, the artistic skill of colouring and lightening hair and how to provide a good consultation service for your clients. This course is suitable for 16-18 year olds.

Course training content: Health & Safety / Client consultation / Shampoo & condition the hair and scalp / Art of dressing hair / Cutting hair / Colour & Lighten hair / Create / Plait & Twisting hair / Promote products and services / Salon reception / Working in the hair industry.

Progression route after Level 2 Diploma in hairdressing here at Bodmin College 6th Form is the VTCT Level 3 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing which is a qualification that has been specifically designed to develop your practical skills to an advanced level through a variety of techniques

Course training units: Monitor & maintain Health & Safety practices / the creative art of cutting women's hair / the artistic skill of colouring / imaginative dexterity of styling and dressing hair / and how to provide effective consultation support for colleagues.

To develop your skills further you will also be given the opportunity to complete the following practical units: bridal hairstyling and the technical colour correction unit.

The VTCT Level 2 is aimed at learners aged 16-18 who wish to pursue a career as an employed and / or self-employed junior hairdresser / hairstylist.

The progression course, VTCT Level 3 is for learners who wish to build advanced hairdressing skills & techniques.
