The courses are modular, and you will build up a portfolio of evidence that will lead to gaining a nationally recognised qualification in Information Technology Systems. Some units may also lead you to gaining recognised qualifications from external companies such as Cisco and Microsoft.

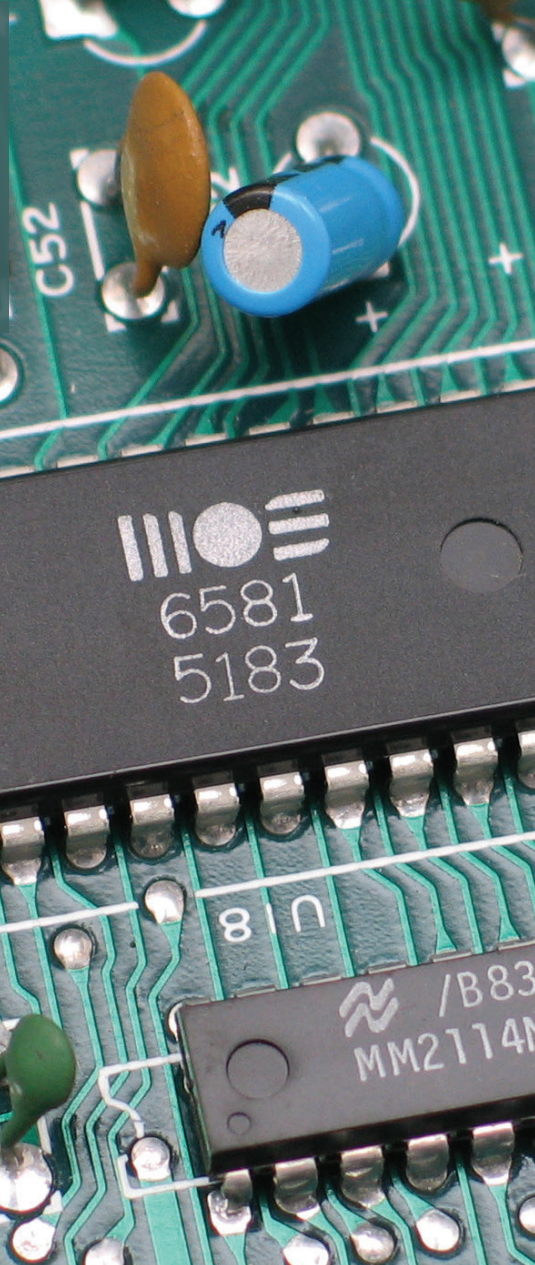
Entry Requirements:

There are no entry requirements to this course other than an interest in the subject and a commitment to doing well.

Is this for me?

The Level 3 Vocational ICT courses are designed to give students hands-on practical skills in building computers, website design, networking, maintaining systems, computer forensics, networking, installation and fault diagnosis.

You can go on to university to study for a degree in Computing, Computing Science or Game Design. You may want to work in a technical role maintaining computers, servers and network devices or in web design. The course is equivalent to three A levels for those students who complete the Level 3 Extended Diploma.
