Pre-Vocational Study BTEC Entry Levels 1, 2 & 3

Entry Requirements: Learners need to have a genuine interest in acquiring independent life skills with a view to obtaining supported employment / voluntary community work. Prospective students need to have basic numeracy and literacy skills and be working towards or at Entry Level 1 in these subjects. Students will be expected to manage basic personal care independently.

What will I do?

All learners taking the BTEC course will complete various units to build a portfolio of work.

Typical units within the Pre-Vocational Suite will include:

- Engaging in personal health and well-being.
- Handling own money and personal budgets.
- Communicating with others.
- Navigating from one place to another.
- Finding out about future options.

Learners will be supported through a variety of tasks, which will encourage and develop independent life skills. Learners will also have the opportunity to experience community projects and supported volunteering placements to enable them to develop employability skills.

Our Post 16 programme is a specialist course for young people with an Educational Health Care Plan. We deliver The Pearson Entry Level in Pre – Vocational Study qualification at Entry Levels 1, 2 and 3, and learners will be encouraged to engage in independent study.

All learners will be given the opportunity to embed theory work with practical tasks enabling them to develop generic and transferrable skills with which they can progress to supported employment or further study.
