Bodmin College and Jason Thomas Dance School Partnership Rationale

The intention of the partnership is one in which we enable wider access to appropriate high quality educational provision in line with ESFA List of qualifications approved for funding 14-19. The courses will be delivered over a one year period. The partnership will work to ensure compliance and excellence in:

- the management and control of the contract
- the welfare of the young people involved
- students' access to the full entitlement of study programmes and student support
- the overall quality of the education and/or training being delivered under the subcontracting arrangement
