- Monday 1<sup>st</sup> December, 9.00am – deadline for submission of preferences

We are aiming to notify students of their allocated activity prior to the end of the Autumn Term.

- Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> January – deadline for payment 1, approximately 1/3 of the cost of the activity
- Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February – deadline for payment 2, approximately 1/3 of the cost of the activity
- Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March – deadline for the final balance of the activity
