We seek an experienced, enthusiastic and committed Tutor to teach Level 2 & 3 BTEC and Construction Skills qualifications. Salary to be paid at QTS or Unqualified Teacher rate as appropriate.

The HLTA role will also run alongside the Tutor post in accordance with the job description.

The College has a strong vocational teaching background and is continually expanding in this area. The results have been consistently outstanding, with students who are positively engaged with the courses on offer. Our Construction students are at KS4 and 5 and gain knowledge of a range of trades, understanding the links and relationship between them.

The Construction courses offered at Bodmin College give a broad insight into the construction industry and aim to give learners the knowledge, skills and techniques to safely carry out a wide range of practical tasks covering many different construction trades allowing for opportunities to embark on a diverse array of careers.

We presently run the BTEC Level 1/Level 2 First Award in Construction and the Built Environment at KS4 allowing progression in to KS5 where we offer NOCN CSkills Awards - Level 2 Diploma in Building Maintenance, Multi-Trade Repairs and Refurbishment Operations and NOCN CSkills Awards - Level 2 Diploma in Fitted Interiors.

The courses are delivered at our off-site Centre, alongside a range of other vocational qualifications. OFSTED were particularly impressed by the quality of work in the vocational courses.
